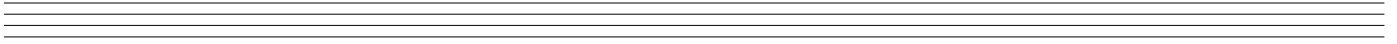


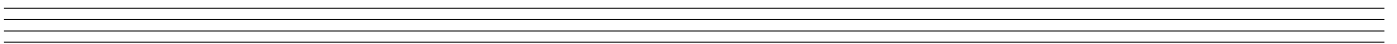
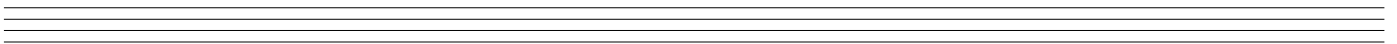
# Note Reading

Remember: always check your HEIGHT and DISTANCE before you play. Sit tall and free!  
Find your natural piano hand shape, drop freely into the key, and land on your fingertip.

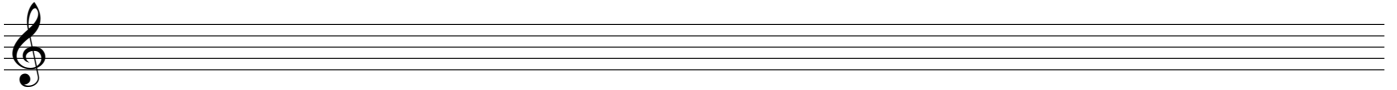
Write steps on the staff, from the bottom all the way to the top and back down. Include ledger lines.



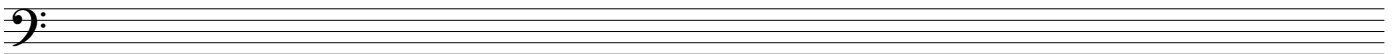
Write several short "snake songs:" 4 or 5 steps on the staff moving up, down and changing direction. Play the "song" on the piano.



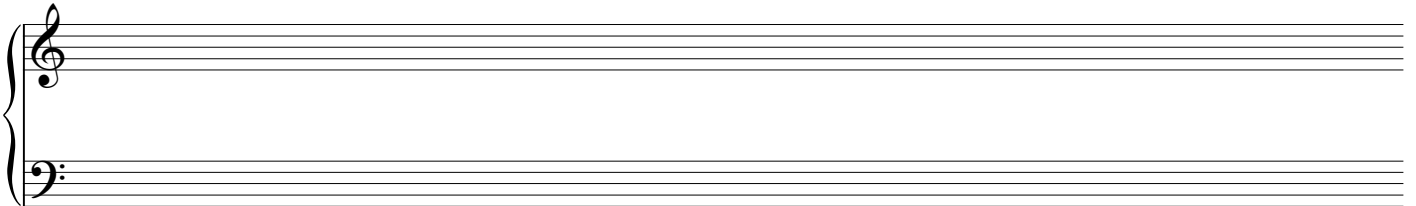
Label the note "G" on the Treble Clef/G clef. Write the note "G" on the staff, then write all the notes stepping DOWN from Treble Clef G to Middle C.



Label the "F" on the Bass Clef/F clef. Write the note "F" on the staff, then write all the notes stepping UP from Bass Clef F to middle C.



Write the letter names of the space notes on the grand staff. Do you see the word "FACE" on both clefs?



Label the note G on the G clef, the note F in the F Clef. Write in "FACEGB" on both treble and bass clefs. Then write some more "snake songs," and play them on the piano.
